Bart van Tiggelen writes from Holland to say: we are the European distributor for Kilmartin sheetmetal (in Australia). Since a lot of the unrestored Healey Hundreds are in a vary bad condition, we decided to produce brand new inner body structures. We have been developing this to perfection over the past 10 months and we now are able to deliver these inner structures to customers. We use them ourselves with our own restorations.

They are produced with the original in mind. All sheetmetal, pressings, welding, routing holes, everything is exactly as the original. They are delivered in chromatid epoxy primer. Delivery time is 2-3 weeks.
