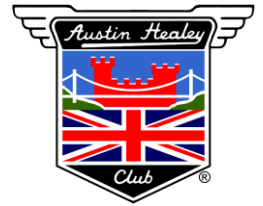




HEALEY NEWS SOUTH-WESTERN
